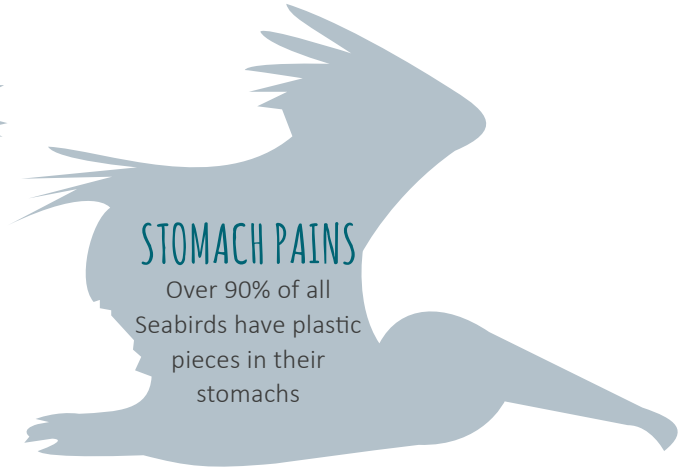

## STOMACH PAINS

Over 90% of all  
Seabirds have plastic  
pieces in their  
stomachs

## BIN FOR THE WIN

Roll up any unwanted  
fishing line into a ball.  
Cut through the ball to  
make short lengths of  
line and place that into  
a secure bin

## MIND YOUR LINE

Birds often get entangled  
in fishing line, never leave  
a line unattended

## THE COLD HARD FACTS

There were 1,382  
entangled animals  
reported to WIRES in 2017  
That's over 3 every day!

## REPORT A RESCUE

If you find a native animal  
needing rescue call WIRES

## PICKING UP THE PIECES

Pick up any trash you see  
when you are out, even if it  
is not yours

## DON'T GET HOOKED

Be careful when picking  
up or disposing of fishing  
hooks, especially if they  
are rusty
